

Anchorage Audiology Clinic Cost Disclosure

Per Alaska SB 105: A health care provider (and health care facility) shall annually compile a list, including a brief description in plain language that an individual with no medical training can understand, of the 10 health care services most commonly performed by the health care facility in the state in the previous calendar year from each of the six sections of Category 1, using current procedural terminology adopted by the American Medical Association and, for each of those services state (1) the procedure code, (2) the undiscounted price, and (3) any facility fees*.

The following is a list of our 10 most common procedures:
